What the Programme Offers

This highly successful in-person programme, recognised by the Institute of Leadership and Management (ILM), was introduced in partnership with Chief Executives and the Local Government Association. It aims to develop practical strategic leadership skills immediately applicable in the workplace. This is the 45th cohort, and over 800 local authority managers have attended the programme thus far. It is held at King's College, The Strand, London.

Participants will learn how to challenge future service provision in a rapidly changing digital world and lead and deliver successful change using "hard skills" of commercial and strategic decision-making and "soft skills" of influencing, persuading, inspiring high performance, and building agile cross-functional collaborative teams. They will also gain practical tools and techniques for leading strategic and tactical change all of which will prepare them for the Local Government Reorganisation.

We developed a very successful virtual classroom approach during Covid. Our online tools for collaborative working on Strategic Analysis etc. have proved to be very beneficial for delegates and their teams. We now combine In-Person delivery with online analysis tools.

What are the Outcomes?

Participants will gain 21st-century strategic leadership skills enabling them to lead practically and virtually, ready to:

- Apply strategic thinking skills and tools to improve the quality of decision-making and reimagine services in a post-Covid world
- Apply commercial thinking using tools and skills to understand competitive forces and customer analysis
- Lead strategic change, practically and virtually, by creating a vision and appropriate change strategy
- Equip and skilled for LGR challenges
- Lead implementation by translating strategy into change projects and programmes
- Increase leadership influence, build trusting relationships and psychologically safe working environments
- Build high performing agile and virtual internal and multi agency collaborative teams
- Make a positive impact by communicating with influence
- Be better equipped to make a case for ongoing investment in and recognition of your services.


Venue
